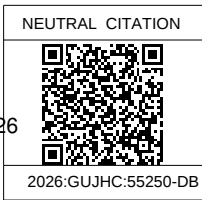

1. The prayer in this writ petition is to direct the respondents to forthwith release and pay the outstanding dues payable to the petitioner under a contract for providing vehicles on hire at LPG Bottling Plant at Bhavnagar.

2. The contract was terminated at risk and cost and while computing the risk and cost amount, 15% supervision charges amounting to ₹8,63,579/- were imposed.

3. The matter was thereafter argued on this aspect and we suggested to the Indian Oil Corporation that these supervision charges should be waived and accordingly the learned counsel appearing for the Indian Oil



Corporation has secured instructions from the Indian Oil Corporation, who has agreed to waive these 15% supervision charges.

4. In light of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that he would not dispute the other claims made by the Indian Oil Corporation in respect of the terminated contract and would accept the same.

5. Consequently, the writ petition is DISPOSED OF by directing the Indian Oil Corporation to pay the dues to the petitioner after deducting the risk and cost amount of ₹3,12,305/-, 15% supervision charges and GST charges on the said amount of Rs.1,55,444/-, both of them together.

6. The petitioner shall accordingly upload his bills for the necessary payment.
